



Consultation Checklist

This checklist is designed to aid you in asking questions during your consultation.

Qualifications

Your doctor is a Board Certified plastic surgeon and is a member in good standing of key professional societies. Medical facilities are fully accredited and anesthesia is administered by a qualified medical professional.

Privileges

Your doctor has operating room privileges to perform the procedure you are having in an accredited operating room. It is best to confirm that your doctor meets the standards to perform the procedure in the office-based operating room.

Professionalism

Your doctor listens to your desires and addresses your aesthetic goals. You are not offered additional, unrelated procedures but only solutions to what you hope to achieve. The doctor and staff are clear, organized, attentive, respectful, and concise.

Proof

Through the sharing of before and after photographs, your doctor has performed the procedure you are considering many times demonstrating actual results on recent patients.

Health

Address any physical or emotional health conditions you may have because they may possibly influence your cosmetic surgery choices. You will need a medical evaluation and lab work prior to treatment.

Cost

You accept the defined cost of surgery which includes a surgical fee, operating room fee, anesthesiologist fee, possible overnight stay fee, and an optional private nurse fee. You are not offered any special deal, nor are you looking for one.
